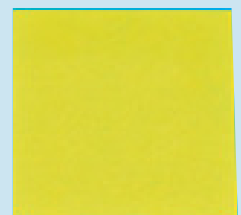
Bees are one of the most hard working bugs out there and certainly one of the most important ones.

To celebrate their awesomeness, let us create an origami bee!



WHAT YOU NEED

1. Yellow fluorescent paper (Get it here-<https://www.myveda.co.ke/shop/>)
2. Round stickers (For the eyes)
3. Black felt pen (All materials are available at My Veda Online Store. Shop Now - <https://www.myveda.co.ke/shop/>)



HOW

1. Fold a square piece of yellow fluorescent paper in half from corner to corner to make a triangle.

Then, connect the other two corners in the similar way. You will get cross folds.



3. Pull the upper corner and fold it, connecting with the opposite side edge. We need this step to mark the half page fold.



5. Raise the right side of the figure upwards, aligning it along the central fold.



7. The resulting figure resembles a big-eared bunny. Turn the raised sides, or ears, into wings.

To achieve that, lower them down and fold, slightly directing them sideward.



2. Fold the paper in half again with its corner up.



4. Unfold the corner to its initial position. Fold the bottom side upwards, reaching the fold made at the previous stage.



6. Direct the left side upwards in the similar way, connecting the sides in the upper corner area.



8. Now, fold small corners to achieve the right bee shape.

Fold the small upper corner downwards.



9. Then, make a bend-fold in the same area, reaching the upper part of the wings.



11. Fold the wings corners backwards as well.



Now it is your turn to become a crafty bee! Using the step-by-step guide illustrated here, make your own Origami Bee.

You can have any of your family member join in the fun. After all, the more the merrier!

10. Fold the side corners backwards. The working area is shown with flowers.



12. Use black felt pen to draw curved stripes. Use the round stickers to place the eyes.
